Autumn Jubilee Quilt Along From My Carolina Home Jar Blocks



Medium Jar Units - Make 4 (7-1/2 x 6-1/2-inch unfinished units), then add BG fills

Cutting for 2 Medium Jar blocks	Scrappy Fabrics	Background (BG)
6-1/2 x 6-1/2-inch squares (jar)	4	
3-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch strips (lid)	4	
1-1/2-inch squares		8
2-inch squares		8
1-1/2 x 2-inch rectangles		8
6-1/2 x 3-1/4 inch rectangles		2
6-1/2- x 3-1/2-inch rectangles		2
6-1/2 x 5-1/2-inch rectangles		2

Position a 1-1/2-inch background square on bottom corner of each jar square and sew diagonally across the square. Position a 2-inch background square on top corner of each jar square and sew diagonally across the square, like making a snowball block. Trim the seam allowances to 1/4-inch. Press to the jar side. Sew one $1-1/2 \times 2$ -inch strip to two opposite sides of each lid strip. Sew lid unit to jar unit. Unit will measure $7-1/2 \times 6-1/2$ -inches. Repeat for four medium jar units.

On two jar units, sew one $6-1/2 \times 3-1/4$ inch rectangle to the top, and one to the bottom.

On two jar units, sew a $6-1/2 \times 5-1/2$ -inch rectangle to the top.

Pair a bottom jar unit with a mid-strip jar unit and sew together creating two medium jar blocks with two jars each, offset.

Small and Large Jar Block

4-1/2 x 6-1/2-inch rectangle	1	
8-1/2 x 6-1/2-inch rectangle	1	
3-1/4 x 1-1/2-inch strip (small lid)	1	
3-1/2 x 1-1/2 strip (Lg lid)	1	
1-1/2-inch squares		4
2-inch squares		4
1-1/2 x 1-1/8-inch rectangles		2
1-1/2 x 2-inch rectangles		2
5-1/2 x 4-1/2 inch rectangle		1
6-1/2- x 3-1/2-inch rectangle		1

Position a 1-1/2-inch background square on bottom corner of each jar square and sew diagonally across the square. Position a 2-inch background square on top corner of each jar square and sew diagonally across the square, like making a snowball block. Trim the seam allowances to 1/4-inch. Press to the jar side.

On one jar lid $3-1/4 \times 1-1/2$ -inch strip, sew one $1-1/2 \times 1-1/8$ -inch rectangle to two opposite sides of each lid strip. Sew small lid unit to small jar unit. Sew the $5-1/2 \times 4-1/2$ inch rectangle to the top of the small jar.

On large jar lid 3-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch strip, sew one 1-1/2 x 2-inch rectangle to two opposite sides of each lid strip. Sew large lid unit to large jar unit. Sew the $6-1/2 \times 3-1/2$ inch rectangle to the top of the bottom of the large jar.

Sew the large jar unit to the small jar unit with the small jar on the left.
