Apple Block


Apple Units - Make 3 (4-1/2 x 5-1/2-inch unfinished units)

| Cutting for 1 block | Scrappy Fabrics | Background (BG) |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| $4-1 / 2 \times 3-1 / 2$-inch rectangles | 3 |  |
| $1 \times 2-1 / 2$-inch strips | 3 |  |
| 1-1/2-inch squares |  | 12 |
| $2-1 / 4 \times 2-1 / 2$ inch rectangles |  | 6 |
| $7-1 / 2-\times 4$ 4-1/2-inch rectangles |  | 2 |
| $4 \times 4-1 / 2$-inch rectangles |  | 2 |

On the background squares, draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner. Place the squares on the corners of the each of the $4-1 / 2 \times 3-1 / 2$-inch rectangles. Sew on the line. Trim to a quarter inch seam allowance. Press the seam to one side.

Sew a background strip to each side of the stem square on the 2-1/2-inch side. Sew the stem units to the apple units.

On one apple unit, sew a 7-1/2- x 4-1/2-inch background rectangle to the top of the apple. On one apple unit, sew a $7-1 / 2-\mathrm{x} 4-1 / 2$-inch background rectangle to the bottom of the apple.
On one apple unit, sew a 4-x 4-1/2-inch background rectangle to the top and bottom of the apple.
Sew the three apple strip units together, with apples on the top left, center, and bottom right.
