

Autumn Jubilee Quilt Along
From My Carolina Home
Apple Block



Apple Units - Make 3 (4-1/2 x 5-1/2-inch unfinished units)

Cutting for 1 block	Scrappy Fabrics	Background (BG)
4-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangles	3	
1 x 2-1/2-inch strips	3	
1-1/2-inch squares		12
2-1/4 x 2-1/2 inch rectangles		6
7-1/2- x 4-1/2-inch rectangles		2
4 x 4-1/2-inch rectangles		2

On the background squares, draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner. Place the squares on the corners of the each of the 4-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangles. Sew on the line. Trim to a quarter inch seam allowance. Press the seam to one side.

Sew a background strip to each side of the stem square on the 2-1/2-inch side. Sew the stem units to the apple units.

- On one apple unit, sew a 7-1/2- x 4-1/2-inch background rectangle to the top of the apple.
- On one apple unit, sew a 7-1/2- x 4-1/2-inch background rectangle to the bottom of the apple.
- On one apple unit, sew a 4- x 4-1/2-inch background rectangle to the top and bottom of the apple.

Sew the three apple strip units together, with apples on the top left, center, and bottom right.
