

Pumpkins - Make 4 (6-1/2-inch unfinished units)

| Cutting for 6 <br> blocks | $2-1 / 2$-inch x 5- <br> $1 / 2$-inch strips | $1-1 / 2$-inch <br> squares | $3 \times 1-1 / 2$-inch <br> strips | $6-1 / 2$-inch <br> squares |

| Scrappy Fabrics | 12 (oranges) | 4 (stems) |  |  |
| Background (BG) |  | 16 | 8 | 4 |

Sew 3 orange strips together on the long sides. Position a 1-1/2-inch background square on each corner and sew diagonally across the square, like making a snowball block. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4-$ inch. Press to the orange side. Sew one 3-1/2-inch strip to two opposite sides of each stem square. Sew stem unit to pumpkin unit. Square up to $6-1 / 2$-inches. Repeat for four pumpkin units.

Arrange pumpkin units on opposite corners with $6-1 / 2$-inch BG squares on remaining areas. Sew one unit with pumpkins on lower left and upper right, and the other unit with pumpkins on lower right and upper left.

Makes two 12-1/2-inch pumpkin blocks.

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
