

# Turkey Talk Placemats From My Carolina Home

## Fabric Requirements

1/2 yard turkey print fabric  
3/4 yard dark background feather fabric  
1/3 yard light background feather fabric  
1/2 yard neutral background



## Cutting

Fussy Cut 4 turkeys at 6-1/2-inches  
Cut 4 dark background feather fabric squares 7-3/4-inches square  
Cut 16 neutral background squares 4-3/8-inches square  
Cut 12 neutral background corner squares 3-1/2-inches square  
Cut 8 light background feather fabric sidebars - 3-1/2 inches x 12-1/2 inches

## Instructions

Using the 4 dark feather fabric 7-3/4-inches squares and the 16 neutral background 4-3/8-inches squares, make 16 no-waste flying geese. See the tutorial on my website for step by step instructions.

Arrange flying geese around the fussy cut turkey squares with feather points facing outward. Add neutral background 3-1/2-inch squares to corners. Sew together.

Add sidebars of light feather fabric, one on each side of a turkey block. (2 per placemat)

Layer with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Finish with binding made from black background feather fabric.
